VENUE

Hereward Wargames Show is held at The Cresset, Rightwell, Bretton, Peterborough, PE3 8DX.

If you are coming by car exit the A47 at junction 16. From either direction exit the A47 on to Bretton Gate, then at the next roundabout take the 4th exit on to Rightwell East (signposted to the Cresset), then left on to Rightwell West – not into the McDonald's. We have over 120 free car parking spaces on site.

If you wind up in Sainsbury's car park, you are at *the wrong end* of the Cresset complex, and you will be charged quite a bit for their parking. Follow the signs on the entrance and retrace your steps back to the other end of the complex.

FOOD AND DRINK

Snacks and drinks will be available on site throughout the day, or if you prefer there is a Sainsbury's next door and a McDonalds over the road. You are welcome to bring a packed lunch if you prefer.

SCHEDULE

The first game begins at 9.30. Games are 55 minutes long. Approximate timings are:

THE TOURNAMENT

The tournament will be played using the rules provided in the *A Game of Thrones: The Card Game Rules Reference*, which may be downloaded from the *A Game of Thrones: The Card Game Fantasy Flight Games* page. (See under registration for web address) The tournament will be played according to Formal Advanced rules. The most recent official FAQ apply.

Players must bring a valid second edition pre built deck with them, which conforms to the official deck building rules as prescribed in the *A Game of Thrones: The Card Game* Rules Reference. Cards within your deck must be sleeved in identical opaque sleeves. Only second edition cards are valid.

SCORING

The tournament will consist of four rounds of Swiss pairings, after which the top four will go through to elimination rounds to determine 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places.

PRIZES

1st Place: A set of 15 Tywin Lannister half Dragon coins from Shire Post mint and an Iron coin of the faceless man. A custom specially designed playmat courtesy of Banter Behind the Throne

2nd Place: A set of 15 Loren Lannister half-penny gamers coins and an iron coin of the faceless man.
